The CPEO program is sponsored and supported by Minneapolis Public Schools' Office of Communications, Engagement, & External Relations. CPEO provides a framework for creating a community in which parents and teachers collaborate to transform each child's educational environment, both at home and at school, so that all children can achieve their greatest academic potential. CPEO is offered for parents with children in elementary, middle, and high schools. The program is taught in four languages, English, Spanish, Hmong, and Somali.
